

## **Covid-19 Responsibilities for ABC Friends Victoria**

**The following policy has been approved by the Committee of Management of ABC Friends Victoria (ABCFV), to take effect on 1 November 2021 and to apply until COVID-19 related restrictions are lifted in Victoria.**

### **Ross House Office:**

Ross House has a Covid-19 Safe Plan, and has existing policies to which all ABCFV people need to adhere. They include proper wearing of face masks at all times, checking in with the QR code, hand cleansing, and social distancing.

ABC Friends Victoria also has its own Covid-19 Safe Plan, which applies to all ABCFV personnel, including staff, volunteers, and all visitors to the Ross House ABCFV office.

In addition to these measures, from 1 November 2021 onwards, any person who enters the ABCFV office needs to be fully vaccinated. Medical exemptions are the only exceptions.

### **Public Activities:**

Any public activities (meetings, stalls, campaigning) held in the name of ABC Friends Victoria need to adhere to the standard public health guidelines, including proper wearing of face masks, checking in with QR codes, social distancing, and hand cleansing.

In addition, from 1 November 2021 onwards, any representative of ABC Friends Victoria needs to be fully vaccinated. Medical exemptions are the only exceptions.
